AMENDMENT OF LEASE PRC 3321, GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: County of San Bernardino Attn: Paul Burton 825 E. 3rd Street San Bernardino, California 92415

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Sourreign land located in the old bed of the Colorado River at Park Moabi, San Bernardino County.

LAND USE: Regional park for public recreational use.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL PERMIT: Initial period:

49 years beginning July 2, 1965.

Consideration: The public benefit.

TERMS OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Amendment to authorize the construction and maintenance of a proposed All ferrain Vehicle (ATV) riding facility. The amendment also clarifies the existing land use which includes maintenance of facilities related to campgrounds, a small boat marina, and a waler treatment plant.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: 2 Cal Adm. Code, Article 2

APPLICANT STATUS:

Applicant is lessee of upland.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Filing fee has been received.


OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 The County of San Bernardino has applied for an amendment of Lease PRC 3321 in order to construct an ATV riding facility. The facility will be fenced and will include a staging area for controlled access. The staging area will include a restroom with holding tank, parking area, landscaping, picnic tables, trash receptacles, and drinking fountain.

Park Moabi has experienced an increase in ATV use over the last five years which has resulted in control and safety problems. The proposed ATV facility will limit riding to a designated area within Park Moabi and therefore enable park staff to better control and supervise such use.

Since the proposed project is intended to improve safety and reduce hazardous situations, the County is requesting a waiver of the \$450 processing fee. The County presently operates Park Moabi as a regional park which includes facilities related to campgrounds, a small boat marina, and a water treatment plant.

 A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by San Bernardino County. The State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document and believes that it complies with the requirements of the CEQA.



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CALENDAR ITEM NO. C11 (CONT'D)

This activity involves lands which have NOT 3. been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "environmental significant"). Since such declaration of significance is not based upon the requirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the finding of the project's consistency with the use classification as required by 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2954 is not applicable.


