

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The Applicant requests use of sovereign lands on which are located several unused concrete block buildings and a rifle range for an army training exercise. The location and facilities are considered ideal for bomb disposal detachment unit training, that includes searching buildings for booby-trap devices. They have assured staff that no structural damage will occur nor will explosives be used. Inasmuch as the training is in the interest of national defense and the time utilized is of short duration, staff recommends waiver of all application and processing fees.
- 2. This activity involves lands which have NOT been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "environmental significant"). Since such declaration of significance is not based upon the requirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the finding of the project's consistency with the use classification as required by 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2954 is not applicable.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA under the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The staff believes there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.




