### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. A lease for this project was approved by the Commission on November 12, 1985, but was never issued because the contractor was urable to perform the work within the time frame authorized.
  - A contractor employed by the involved marinas has reapplied for use of the State-owned land to install a temporary pipeline across the San Joaquin River to transport spoils to Sherman Island. The project remains substantially the same, except spoils will be removed from San Joaquin Harbor and Sportsman Club, Inc. along with Lloyd's Holiday Harbor and New Bridge Marina. All spoils materials are being dredged from privately owned lands.
- 2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15304.
