OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- In order to minimize the effects of increased utilization of living marine resources and to compensate for degradation of the marine environment caused by the increased use of the nearshore waters, the Department of Fish and Game (DFG), along with Southern California Edison Company, are conducting cooperative studies involving fishing reefs, both natural and man-made. The program involves:
  - a. Construction of fishing reefs to increase shelter, forage, breeding and nursery areas for fish, invertebrates and plants; and
  - b. Determination of what role the reefs play in nearshore ecosystems and whether the reefs could be useful in mitigating the effects of industrial development. The studies are providing basic information on reef biology. Further, Assembly Bill 706, enacted in 1985. authorized DFG to conduct a series of experimental reefs for fisheries enhancement and mitigation purposes. As part of these studies, DFG proposes to construct an experimental reef in the nearshore waters of Santa Monica Bay and has applied for a permit. The reef is to be constructed from clean quarried rock, consisting of boulders (2.5 to 4 feet in diameter) and smaller rock (1 to 3 feet in diameter). The reef locations will be marked with buoys and LORAN coordinates will be published for safety purposes and to encourage utilization of the reef.
- 2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$154,602.
- 3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. and the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15304.
