OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- Although the original permit was approved by the Commission to allow two permittees to perform demolition of the antenna equipment, only the Applicant actually acquired the permit and initiated the work. The second party was unable to follow through for financial reasons. Because the estimate of the time period to complete the operation was based on two laborers, the Applicant was unable to complete the work within one year. Therefore, an additional year is requested for a Salvage fermit solely for the Applicant.
- 2. This activity involves lands which have NOT been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "environmental significant"). Since such declaration of significance is not based upon the requirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the finding of the project's consistency with the use classification as required by 2 Cal. Adm. Sode 2954 is not applicable.
