Code 15061), the staff has determined that these activities are exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as categorical exempt projects. These projects are exempt under Class 1 (Existing Facilities, Item Nos. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14); Class 2 (Replacement or Reconstruction, Item Nos. 7 and 12); and Class 3 (New Construction, Item No. 3), 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

- 2. These activities involve lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the projects as proposed are consistent with the lands' use classification.
- 3. Lake Tahoe Application: The Commission at its meeting on November 27, 1978, suspended all leasing for new construction at Lake Tahoe, except for mooring buoys in designated areas. This action was taken pending completion of an EIR which addresses the cumulative impact of continued construction of piers in Lake Tahoe. Each of the applications herein are for the continued use of existing piers in the lake, and therefore are not subject to the Commission's suspension of leasing activities for new construction.

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
