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
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APPROVAL OF AN INTERIM LIQUID PETROLEUM GAS PRODUCTS SALES CONTRACT (LONG BEACH HARBOR DEPARTMENT TIDELANDS PARCEL AND PARCEL "A") AND APPROVAL OF SPECIFICATIONS AND FORMS FOR INVITING BIDS FOR THE SALE OF LIQUID PETROLEUM GAS PRODUCTS FROM THE LONG BEACH HARBOR DEPARTMENT TIDELANDS PARCEL AND PARCEL "A"

Since 1973, the City of Long Beach has had a liquid petroleum gas products sales contract with MacMillan Ring-Free Oil Company, Inc. for the products from the Long Beach Harbor Department Tidelands Parcel and Parcel "A", Wilmington Oil Field, Los Angeles County. Due to MacMillan's financial difficulties and its resultant inability to perform under the contract, the contract was terminated effective September 1, 1987.

The City entered into, on an emergency basis, a Liquid Petroleum Gas Products Sales Contract with Petrolane Gas Service Limited Partnership under which Petrolane purchases the 1500 gallons per day of products on an interim basis. The contract became effective September 1, 1987 and may be terminated on 30 days' written notice from either party. The price paid by Petrolane is the price paid by Chevron U.S.A., Inc. which actually takes delivery of the products. This price is presently \$0.37 per gallon. This interim disposition of the liquid petroleum gas products should be ratified by the Commission.

A bid package has been prepared for the sale by competitive bidding of the liquid petroleum gas products. This competitively bid contract would replace the interim contract



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with Petrolane. Under Section 10(a) of Chapter 29, Statutes of 1956, 1st E.S., the specifications and forms for the purpose of inviting bids for the sale of Long Beach tidelands crude oil products must be approved by the State Lands Commission prior to publication of the notice to bidders. The City plans to hold a bid opening on February 24, 1988. The Commission must then approve the awarding of this contract by the City.

## EXHIBIT "A"

Specifications of Sale of Liquid Petroleum Gas Products from The Long Beach Harbor Department Tidelands Parcel and Parcel "A"

1. Volume

The liquid petroleum gas products from the Long Beach Harbor Department Tidelands Parcel and Parcel "A" amount to approximately 1500 gallons per day.

2. Price

The price will be fixed price per gallon as bid by the purchaser.

3. <u>Term</u>

The contract will be for a term of ten months commencing on May 1, 1988 and expiring on February 28, 1989.

4. Surety

A Letter of Credit equal to + value of 60 days of production (approximately \$30, JO) will be required as well as comprehensive general liability and property damage insurance in amounts of not less than \$2 million.

5. Bid Deposit

A bid deposit of \$25,000 will be required which, except for the highest responsible bidder, will be returned.

## 6. Right to Reject Bids

The City reserves the right to cancel this offer at any time and to reject all bids received.

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
