AWARD OF THE ROYALTY OIL SALES CONTRACT, STATE OIL AND LEASES PRC 3133, PRC 3150, PRC 4000 AND PRC 1824 CARPINTERIA-SUMMERLAND OFFSHORE FIELDS, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

On January 21, 1988, the State Lands Commission authorized the ale of royalty crude oil from State Oil and Gas Leases PRC 3133, PRC 3150, PRC 4000 and PRC 1824, Carpinteria-Summerland Offshore Fields, Santa Barbara County.

Caljet, Inc. is the present purchaser of the State's share of crude oil produced from these leases paying the State a bonus of \$0.56 per barrel above the base price, which is defined as the highest price posted for oil of like quality on the day of delivery in the Carpinteria-Summerland Offshore Fields by Chevron USA, Inc. The State's share of production from these Chevron USA, Inc. The State's share of production from these leases is approximately 14,000 barrels per month of between leases is approximately crude oil. The present contract is 250 - 37.50 API gravity crude oil. The present contract is for a term of one year having begun on December 1, 1987 and is scheduled to terminate on December 1, 1988.

A Notice Inviting Bids was published in the <u>Santa Barbara</u>

<u>News-Press</u> on February 1, 1988 and sent to all known interested parties. Bids were received and opened on February 17, 1988. Exhibit "A" shows the results of the bidding.

Fiscal and legal reviews of the submitted bid material were done by the SLC Auditing and Legal Units respectively. Based on the résults of these reviews, the highest responsible bidder has been identified on Exhibit "A".

Staff recommends the awarding of the Royalty Oil Sales Contract for State Oil and Gas Leases PRC 3133, "RC 3150, PRC 4000 and PRC 1824, Carpinteria-Summerland Offshore Fields, Santa Barbara County, to the highest responsible bidder identified on Exhibit "A" for the period December 1, 1988 until June 1, 1990.
