AND OPERATIONS AND BUDGET, LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LOS ANGELES COUNTY

Section 5, Chapter 138, Statutes of 1964, 1st E.S., and Article 4 of the Long Beach Unit Agreement require adoption by the City of Long Beach of an annual Plan of Development and Operations and Budget for the Long Beach Unit. The Plan and Budget is then to be submitted to the State Lands Commission at least 100 days prior to submission to the participants of the Long Beach Unit before the start of the Plan Year on July 1, 1987.

The Commission has 45 days after submittal to take action. If no action is taken, the Plan and Budget is deemed to be approved as submitted. The Commission may affirmatively approve the Plan and Budget or modify it after holding a formal hearing. Under Section 5(g), the Plan and Budget may be modified upon mutual agreement by the City and the Commission.

The City Council of the City of Long Beach, at its meeting on March 8, 1988, adopted this proposed Plan of Development and Operations and Budget for 1988-89, and authorized its submittal to the State Lands Commission for consideration and approval. The Plan and Budget was submitted to the State by the City on March 15, 1988.

As presented the 1988-89 Long Beach Unit Plan and Burget provides \$132,970,000 in the six budget programs as .ollows: (Thousand of Dollars)

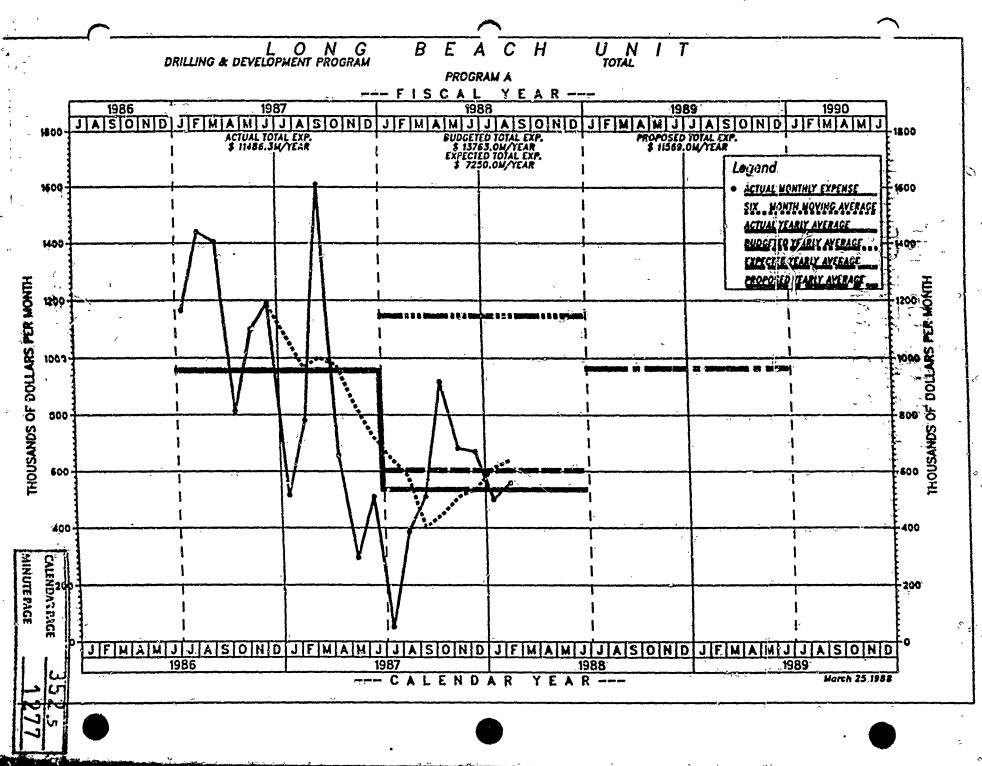
LONG BEACH UNIT BUDGET ALL PROGRAMS



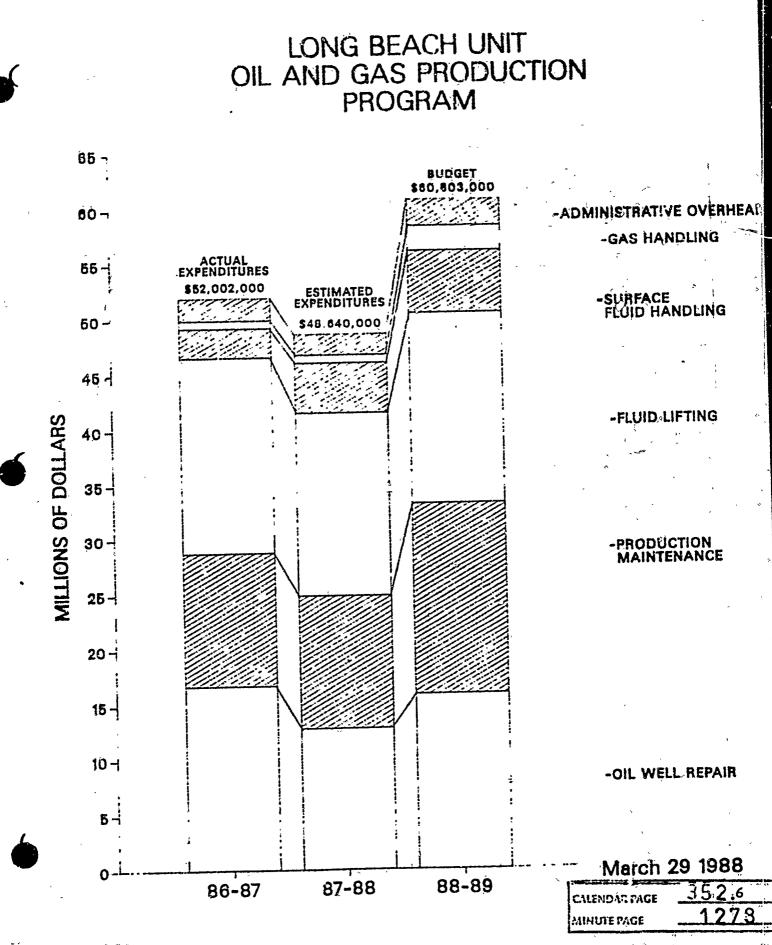
