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CONSIDERATION OF BOUNDARIES AND PROPOSAL TO ANNEX TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS INTO THE CITY OF STOCKTON, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

APPLICANT:

City of Stockton

Office of the City Manager

Stockton, California 95202-1997

The State Lands Commission has received a request from the City of Stockton to review and approve the boundaries for the Weston Ranch Annexation Proposal (A-88-1).

The area proposed for annexation includes approximately 1,960 acres of land, more or less, and includes a 1.5 mile stretch of Interstate 5, a 1.8 mile stretch of the eastern half of the San Joaquin River, and a 1.5 mile stretch of French Camp Slough de los franceses").

The general location of the subject area lies east of the San Joaquin River, south of French Camp Slough, and south and west of the present city boundaries of Stockton. It consists primarily of farm land, but is planned for a 6,580-unit residential development. Any development involving either the San Joaquin River or French Camp Slough, both which include tide and submerged lands owned by and under the jurisdiction of the Commission, will require a permit from the State Lands Commission. This would include any dredging, utility lines, docks, or any other similar activity in the

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56108(c) and (d), the Commission is to review and approve or deny the proposed annexation boundaries as appropriate and correct.

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Pursuant to Government Code Section 56108(a), the Commission must consent before land under its jurisdiction can be annexed.

The staff of the Commission has reviewed the proposed annexation boundary description and finds it adequate pursuant to Section 56108(c) and (d). Furthermore, the staff has no objection to transfer of local political jurisdiction from the County of San Joaquin to the City of Stockton pursuant to

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AND FRENCH CAMP SLOUGH WITHIN THE AREA DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 56108(a), WHICH CONSENT SHALL BE VALID FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR, DURING WHICH THAT PROPOSED ANNEXATION MUST BE FINALIZED.

All that certain real property, being a portion of Sections 21, 22, 27, 28, 33 and 34, Township 1 North, Range 6 Eas' Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, and also being a portion of Sections C, D, 11 and 12 of the C. M. Weber Grant ("El Rancho del Campo de los Franceses"), within the County of San Joaquin, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:
