CALENDAR ITEM

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AUTHORIZATION TO HOLD HEARING ON A REQUEST FOR RETROCESSION OF EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION AT THE PRESIDIO OF MONTEREY

APPLICANT:

Department of the Army Corps of Engineers 650 Capital Mall

Sacramento, California 95814-4794

The United States has exclusive legislative jurisdiction over the Presidio of Monterey. The Department of the Army has entered into two leases with the City of Monterey for use of portions of the Presidio lands as a nature preserve and historical site. The United States and the City request that there be a retrocession of exclusive jurisdiction and establishment of concurrent jurisdiction at these sites.

California Government Code, Section 113, requires that the Commission conduct a public hearing to receive comments from the public relative to the proposed retrocession of jurisdiction. This calendar item requests the Commissioners to delegate to Commission staff the necessary authority to conduct the hearing. After the hearing, the matter will be returned to the Commission for consideration of the retrocession request.

Beginning at a point of commencement at monument number 6419 (more specifically defined as a marking corner common to the Military Reservation and Rancho Pescadero on "lisensed Surveyors Map of El Pescadero and Point Pinos Rancho" filed in volume 3 page 3 of Surveys in the Records of Monterey County, California) thence running S 330 44' POB is further defined as the point of Beginning (POB). This Presidio of Monterey Military Reservation most western boundary line (S 330 44' 10" E) and the easterly right-of-way line of State Highway 68 (N 570 07' 32" W). the following 23 courses,

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EL CASTILLO PARK (Lower) Presidio of Monterey

Beginning at a point of commencement at a monument located at the high waterline of Monterey Bay on the northerly side of the Presidio of Monterey. Said monument is shown on Map Number 6525-99 entitled "Reservation Map of the Presidio of Monterey, California dated October 1907, corrected September 18, 1933, on file in the office of The Quartermaster General (A.G. 600-93 Presidio of Monterey (10-10-33) Pub.) and as said monument is called out in the description on that map of the Presidio of Monterey filed in Volume 2 of Maps (Outside Lands), Page 3, Records of Monterey County, California, August 9, 1913. From this point of commencement move along said northerly boundary line of the Presidio of Monterey. S 890 30' W, 732.92 feet to a point on the westerly right of-way line of Lighthouse Avenue (Reference taken from that certain Quit Claim Deed filed in Reel 963, page 718, Official Records of Monterey County) to the Point of Beginning (POB).

The Point of Beginning is also defined from another point of commencement from the original northwest granite monument along the northerly boundry line between the Presidio of Monterey and the City of Monterey as shown on that certain map filed in Volume 1 Cities and Towns on Page 44 in the Recorder's Office of Monterey County, California. From this granite monument N 89° 30' E for 3263.68 feet to the same Point of Beginning (PO3). From this POB

S 670 17' 30" E, 140.43 feet to-the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, thence; S 62° 26' E, 586.60 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve, thence; along said curve to the right 530.81 feet having an angle of 76° 02' with a radius of 400 feet: S 13° 36' W, 38.00 feet; N 76° 24' W 10.00 feet; S 21° 24' 12" W (S 22° 15' 12" W) 243.94 feet; S 18° 29' W (S 19° 20' W), 320.00 feet; S 71° 23' 57" E (S 70° 37' 57" E, 47.69 feet), 47.73 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve, thence; along said curve to the right 35.61 feet having an angle of 81° 36' 42" with a radius of 25 feet (81° 44' 54", length of 35.67 feet having a radius of 25 feet) to the South Boundary of the Presidio of Monterey thence; running westerly along said South Boundary the following ten (10) courses; 5 800 W, 156.35 feet; N 51° 33' W, 164.34 feet; S 82° 30' W, 77.97 feet; N 74° 45' W, 92.36 feet; N 69° W, 90.38 feet; N 30° W, 109.51 feet; N 69° W, 105.55 feet; S 68° W, 65.97 feet; S 86° 13' W, 146.12 feet; S 59° 15' W, 150.19 feet; thence leaving said South Boundary of the Presidio of Monterey: N 10 30' W, 523.47 feet; N 890 30' E, 36.00 feet; N 10 30' W, 85.00 feet; S 89° 30' W, 65.00 feet; N 1° 30' W, 43.83 feet; N 61 30' W, 45.22 feet; N 1º 30' W, 130.00 feet; S 69º 45' E, 30.00 feet to the beginning of a tangent quive, thence,

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
