OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of
authority and the State CEQA Guidelines
(14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has

determined that these activities are exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as categorical exempt projects. These projects are exempt under Class 1 (Existing Facilities, Item Nos. D, E, F & G); Class 2 (Replacement or Reconstruction) Item Nos. A & H); and Class 3 (New Construction, Item No. B & C), 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

2. These activities involve lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the projects as proposed are consistent with the lands' use classification.
3. Lake Tahoe Application: The Commission at its meeting on November 27, 1978, suspended all leasing for new construction at Lake Tahoe, except for mooring buoys in designated areas. This action was taken pending completion of an EIR which addresses the cumulative impact of continued construction of piers in Lake Tahoe. Each of the applications herein are for the continued use of existing piers in the lake, and therefore are not subject to the Commission's suspension of leasing activities for new construction.
4. All permits covering structures in Lake Tahoe will include a condition subsequent that if any structure authorized is found to be in nonconformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone ordinance and if any alterations, repairs, or removal required pursuant to said ordinance are not accomplished within the designated time period, then the permit will be automatically terminated, effective upon notice by the State and the site shall be cleared pursuant to the terms thereof.

5. Items D and E are conversions from General Permits -Recreational Use.
6. Regarding Item A, the proposed pier and existing pier are located adjacent to a common area, the upland of which is to be developed into six individual residential parcels. It is the Applicant's intent to use the two piers for multiple use and, therefore, no additional piers will be built at the site.
