LEASE SUMMARY:

State oil and gas lease PRC 7004 was issued to TXO Production Corp. on August 28, 1986. This lease contains approximately 95.7 acres of submerged land in the bed of the Sacramento River, Glenn County, California. This lease also contains a three year drilling term and prohibits the surface use of the leased lands for oil and gas operations.

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On August 26, 1988, a full Quitclaim Deed for State oil and gas lease PRC 7004 was filed with the Commission. This deed was executed by the lessee on August 25, 1988.

STATUTUORY AND OTHER AUTHORITY:

P.R.C. 6804.1 and paragraph 30 of State oil and gas lease PRC 7004 provide that the lessee may make at any time a written quitelaim or relinquishment of all rights under the lease or of any portion of the leased lands comprising a ten-acre parcel or multiple thereof in compact form, or of any separate or distinct zone or geological horizon or portion thereof underlying a ten-acre parcel or multiple thereof in compact form. The quitclaim or

relinquishment will be effective when it is filed with the Commission subject to the continued obligation of the lessee and its surety to pay all accrued rentals and royalties and to abandon all wells drilled on, into or through the leased lands or in the zones or horizons to be quitclaimed or relinquished.

Staff has reviewed information supplied by the lessee and other data in the files of the Commission and has found no default existing on State oil and gas lease PRC 7004 as of August 26, 1988, the filing date of the quitclaim deed. Therefore, pursuant to P.R.C. 6804.1 and the terms of the lease, the effective date of the quitclaim will be August 26, 1988.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. As of August 26, 1988, all rentals have been paid for a total of \$9,600 during the two-year lease term. No royalties are due as the lease was never developed. One well was drilled near the leased land and this well was properly abandoned in accordance with the terms of the lease and the rules and regulations of the Commission and the Division of Oil and Gas. A copy of the Division of Oil and Gas "Notice of Intention to Abandon Well" is on file in the Long Beach and Sacramento offices of the Commission.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that the acceptance of the quitclaim is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not at "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.


