APPROVAL AND AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXECUTION OF A SETTLEMENT AND BOUNDARY LINE AGREEMENT INVOLVING LANDS IN AND ALONG OXBOW LOOP BEING A PORTION OF THE FORMER BED OF THE SANTA ANA RIVER IN THE CITY OF NEWPORT BEACH AND COUNTY OF ORANGE

PARTIES:

Rancho Santiago Partnership

Mobil Oil Corporation

City of Newport Beach

State Lands Commission

This calendar item recommends settlement of a dispute between the City of Newport Beach, the State, and the record owners of an area of land which lies within the former bed of the Santa Ana River, which is historically a tidal tributary of Newport Bay located primarily within the boundaries of the City of Newport Beach.

The record landowners (Mobil and Rancho Santiago Partnership) claim title to the area in dispute as successors to the confirmed Spanish land grant of Rancho Santiago de Santa Ana.

The State and City assert that the tidal and submerged lands lying within the Santa Ana River within the area in question were not included in the Spanish land grant and were not within the United States patent confirming that land grant.

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The dispute over the ownership of this land has involved one or more of the parties in at least four law suits regarding their respective interest therein. The negotiations conducted between the parties has finally resulted in a proposed settlement of the dispute which will establish a boundary line separating the private landowners' property within Rancho Santiago de Santa Ana to the north and the tide and submerged lands within the former bed of the Santa Ana River to the south.

This proposed boundary line is the result of independent studies and analysis by the parties of the available evidence as to location of the last natural ordinary high-water mark along the northerly bank of this portion of the Santa Ana River known as Oxbow Loop. The boundary, as proposed, would be fixed and not subject to change by either natural or man-made causes.

The parties, in order to effectuate this common boundary line, will quitclaim interests on opposing sides of their common boundary. Another element of the agreement is the acknowledgment by the parties that the slough to the north, which is not within the former bed of the Santa Ana River, but is a recreationally navigable tributary thereto, is within the boundaries of Rancho Santiago de Santa Ana and is subject to a public right of navigation, as established by the California courts in <u>Bohn v. Albertson</u>, (1951) 107 Cal.App.3d 738 and <u>People ex rel. Baker v. Mack</u>, (1971) 19 Cal.App.3d 1040.

The Settlement and Boundary Line Agreement provides that the lands lying within Oxbow Loop to be deeded to the City and State shall be held as tide and submerged lands subject to the terms and provisions of Chapter 74, Statutes of 1978.



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
