**RATIFY AUTHORITY TO AWARD CONTRACT TO THE LOWEST BIDDER
FOR THE REMOVAL OF HAZARDOUS STRUCTURES
ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS**

BACKGROUND:

At its September 14, 1988 meeting, the Commission delegated the authority necessary to obtain all permits from other governmental agencies and to solicit bids for the removal hazards associated with prior oil- and gas-related activities in state waters offshore Santa Barbara County. The Commission was provided \$563,000 funding in the 1988-89 Fiscal Year to remove priority hazards identified and prioritized in the Commission's Coastal Hazards Inventory Program which was submitted to the Legislature in June 1986.

The solicitation of bids has occurred, bids have been received, and all necessary permits have been obtained.

REQUEST FOR RATIFICATION:

The period for the removal of the hazardous structures is restricted to a period of February through May by the Coastal Commission permit. The purpose of this restriction is to take advantage of the low sand levels and to avoid the peak recreational period on the beaches within Santa Barbara County. The removal process needs to commence as soon as possible to take advantage of the low tides and the limited time available to complete the hazard removal.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15061 AS A CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 4, REMOVAL OF DERELICT OR HAZARDOUS STRUCTURES ON STATE WATERWAYS OR SCHOOL LANDS, 2 CAL. CODE REGS. 2905(d)(3).
2. AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMOVING THE HAZARDOUS STRUCTURES IN THE SURF ZONE OF STATE COASTAL WATERS IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, WITH LOWEST QUALIFIED BIDDER, OCEANEERING INTERNATIONAL, INC. OF SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA, WHICH SUBMITTED A OF \$138,155.
