TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

The term of the Non-Exclusive Geological Survey  
Permit is three years.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Statutory filing fee, expense deposit, and  
performance bond have been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The geological surveys authorized under the  
terms of the permit are for the purpose of  
obtaining shallow samples of the seafloor  
for geotechnical information. The data  
obtained is used in the design of offshore

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structures (pipelines, marine terminals, platforms, piers, etc.) and in the technical and environmental analyses of offshore oil and gas operations.

The shallow samples are obtained using nonrotary techniques (dart, jet, percussion, grab) from a self-contained vessel. The vessel is typically no larger than fishing boats used in the Santa Barbara Channel (50 to 150 feet in length, six-foot draft).

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et. seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the permit as part of the program for the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 6, Information Collection, the collection of data for information purposes where minimal or no disturbance of State lands is involved, 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905(e)(3).

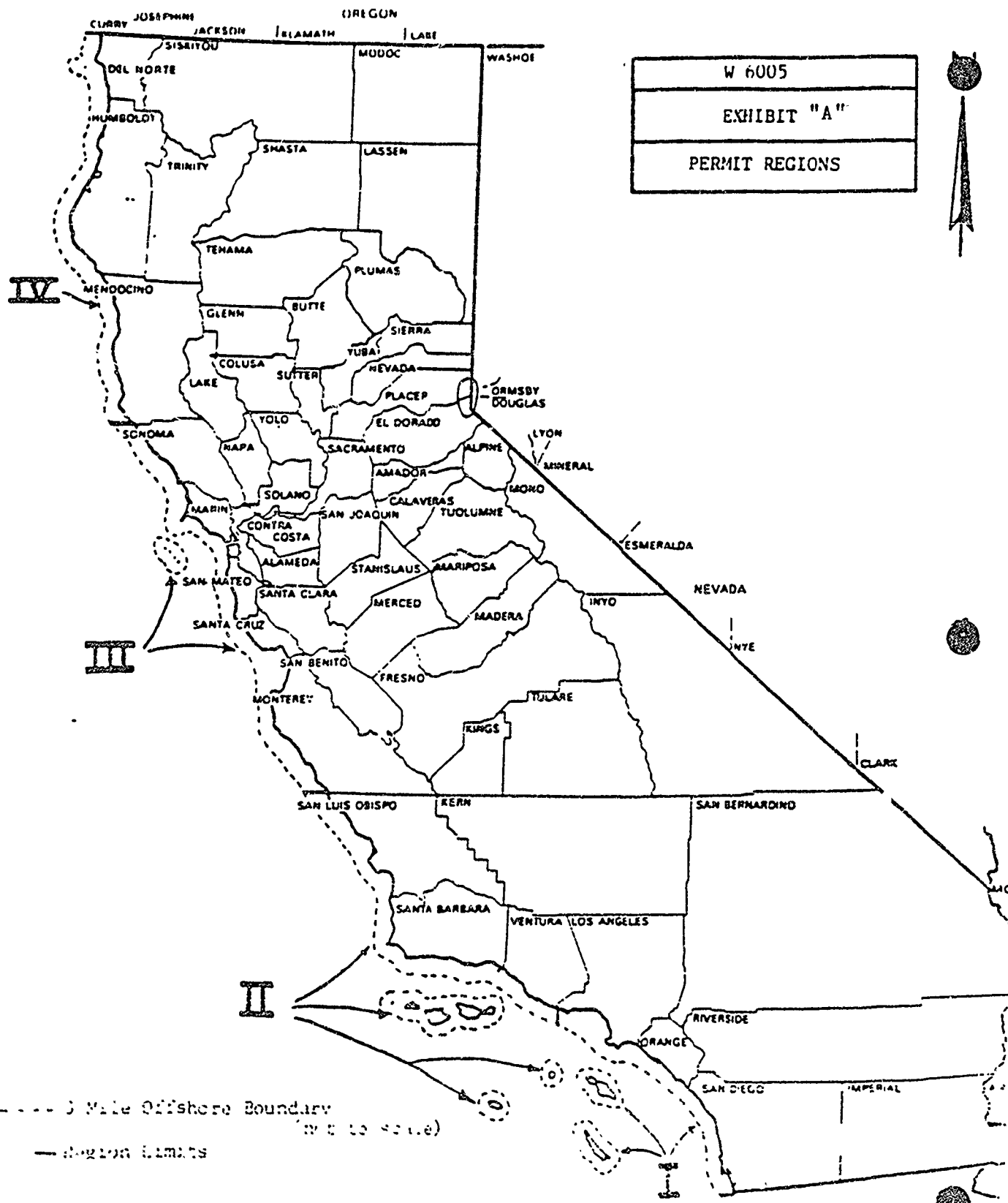
EXHIBIT: A. Permit Regions.

2. AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE TO PELAGOS CORPORATION, OF A NON-EXCLUSIVE GENERAL PERMIT TO CONDUCT GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS ON STATE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 1990 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1993 WITHIN PERMIT REGIONS I, II, III, AND IV AS DEFINED ON EXHIBIT "A" HERETO.
