1. As to the authorization to issue a new lease, pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities., 2 Cal. Code Regs 2905(a)(2).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084, 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15300, and 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905.

2. As to the authorization for inclusion in the self-administered claims program, pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. AS TO THE LEASE REPLACEMENT, FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15061 AS A CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 1, EXISTING FACILITIES, 2 CAL. CODE REGS. 2905(a)(2).
2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CHEVRON U.S.A. OF A TWENTY-YEAR GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE, BEGINNING JUNE 19, 1989; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$439.18, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE, FOR THE LOCATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A SUBMARINE PIPELINE ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
3. AS TO THE AUTHORIZATION FOR INCLUSION IN THE SELF-ADMINISTERED CLAIMS PROGRAM, FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15061 BECAUSE THE ACTIVITY IS NOT A PROJECT AS DEFINED BY P.R.C. 21055 AND 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15378.
4. AUTHORIZE INCLUSION IN SELF-ADMINISTERED CLAIMS PROGRAM, OF LEASE PRC 4224 AND LEASE PRC 4303, EACH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000, AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH 8 OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE "AGREEMENT AND APPROVAL OF SELF-ADMINISTERED CLAIMS PROGRAM CHEVRON CORPORATION" AUTHORIZED BY THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION, JUNE 26, 1986, UNDER W 23833.

No. 5	40°	700 from East Tower
No. 7	49°30'	900 from East Tower

The reference points are towers on the South Shore of the San Joaquin River, shown on USC&GS Chart no. 5527.

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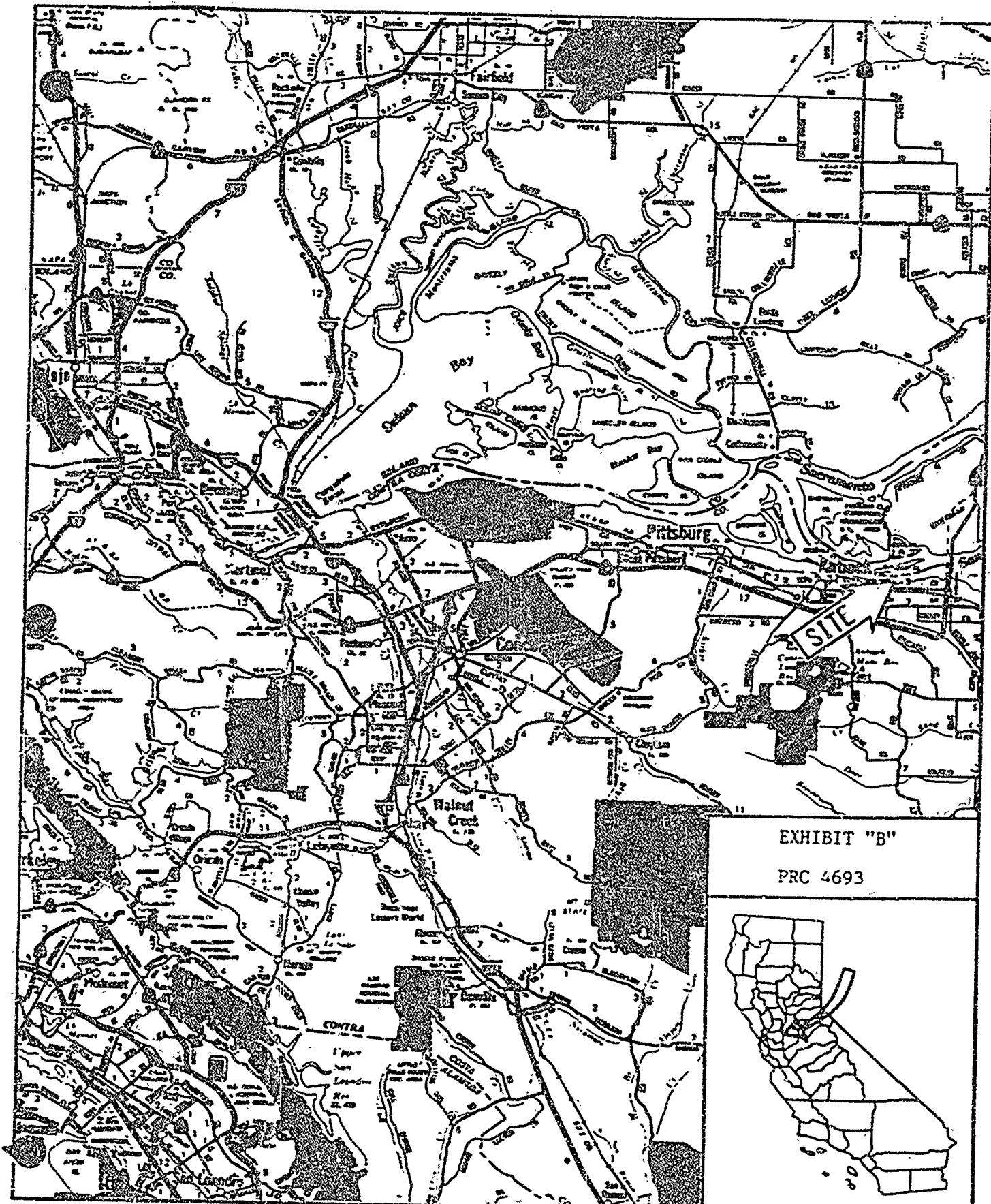
