REPRIORITIZATION OF THE HAZARDS TO BE REMOVED
AS IDENTIFIED WITHIN THE COMMISSION'S HAZARDS INVENTORY
BASED UPON THE CHANGE IN THE ESTIMATED COST
OF REMOVAL OF THE "NEPTUNE"

At the Commission's September 11, 1989 meeting, authority was granted to:

- Find that the hazard "Neptune" located at the City of Isleton was an extreme hazard, as defined by the Commission's criteria contained in the 1986 Hazards Inventory Report.
- Authorized the Executive Officer to transmit a request to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee to add the hazard to the Commission's Hazard Inventory.
- Authorize the Executive Officer to solicit bids for the removal of the hazard, and
- Direct the Executive Officer to pursue recovery of the cost of the removal from the registered owner of the vessel.

The hazard has since been added to the Commission's Hazard Inventory, based on the approval of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee. The solicitation for bids has been made and bids have been received. Only one bid met the criteria required by the Request for Proposals. Sole Source Justification is currently being requested of the Office of Small and Minority Business.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. C 3 8 CONT'D

The estimated cost presented within the calendar item was \$75,000 and the estimated cost for the removal of the vessel is now \$350,000.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 BECAUSE THESE ACTIVITIES ARE NOT PROJECTS AS DEFINED BY P.R.C. 21065 AND 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15378.
2. AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO NOTIFY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE THAT THE ANTICIPATED EXPENDITURE FOR THE "NEPTUNE" WILL BE \$350,000.
