DELEGATE AUTHORITY TO SOLICIT BIDS AND AWARD CONTRACT FOR GROIN REMOVAL WORK AT LAS TUNAS STATE BEACH

### PARTY:

The Commission has been provided \$200,000 as a component of the settlement of litigation in the case of <u>People v. Title Insurance and Trust Company</u> to abate a potential hazard resulting from the existence of five deteriorated steel groins along the coastrine at Las Tunas State Beach in Los Angeles County (W 20527, W 503.1268). These groins are listed as LOS 10 in the Commission's Coastal Hazards Inventory report to the Legislature, June 1986. The abatement project will include removal of four (4) old groins and the buttressing of one groin with armor rock. Staff requests authorization to solicit bids for the abatement project.
