AMEND GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE  
RECREATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

APPLICANT:

City of Palo Alto  
c/o Mr. Edgar Ugarte, Project Manager

Palo Alto, California 94303

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

An undetermined amount of filled, sovereign land in Palo Alto, Santa Clara County.

LAND USE:

Development of portions of Byxbee Landfill Park, adjacent to Mayfield Marsh, Palo Alto, Santa Clara County.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL PERMIT:

Initial period:  
Forty-nine (49) years beginning September 27, 1989.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Pursuant to 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2003.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing fees and processing costs have been received.

**OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

1. The Byxbee Landfill Park is a 146-acre site, used for a long period as a sanitary landfill operation. The project consists of several phases of development. Phase I was completed in August 1991. The lease is proposed to be amended to include Phase IIA as described in the Exhibit "A-1" and "A-2" attached and made a part thereof. This phase of the project, scheduled for completion by July 1992, which consists of additional park improvements as described in the lease document on file.
2. A Negative Declaration, SCH 91053078, was prepared and adopted for this project by the City of Palo Alto. The State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document.

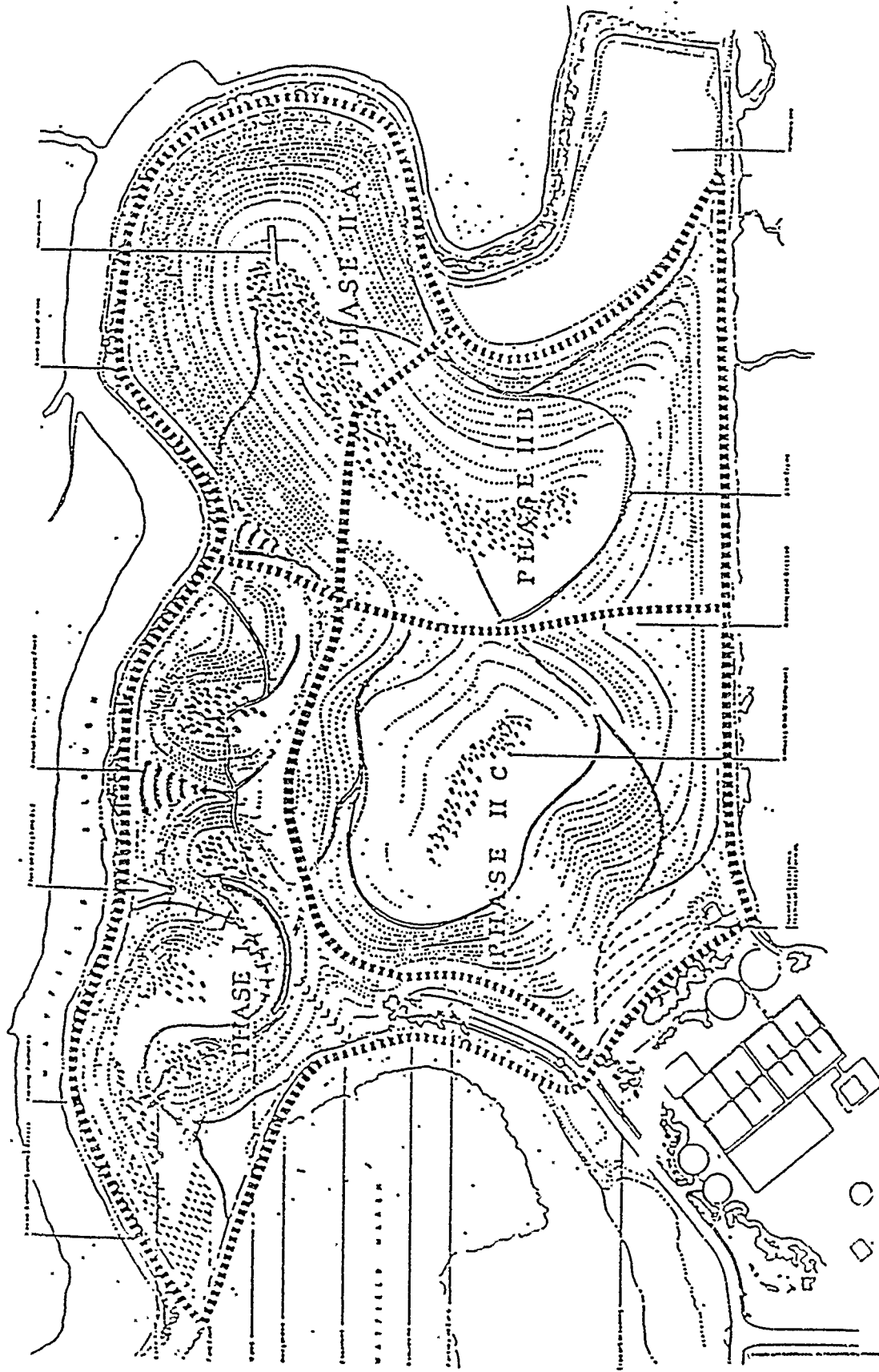
LAND DESCRIPTION

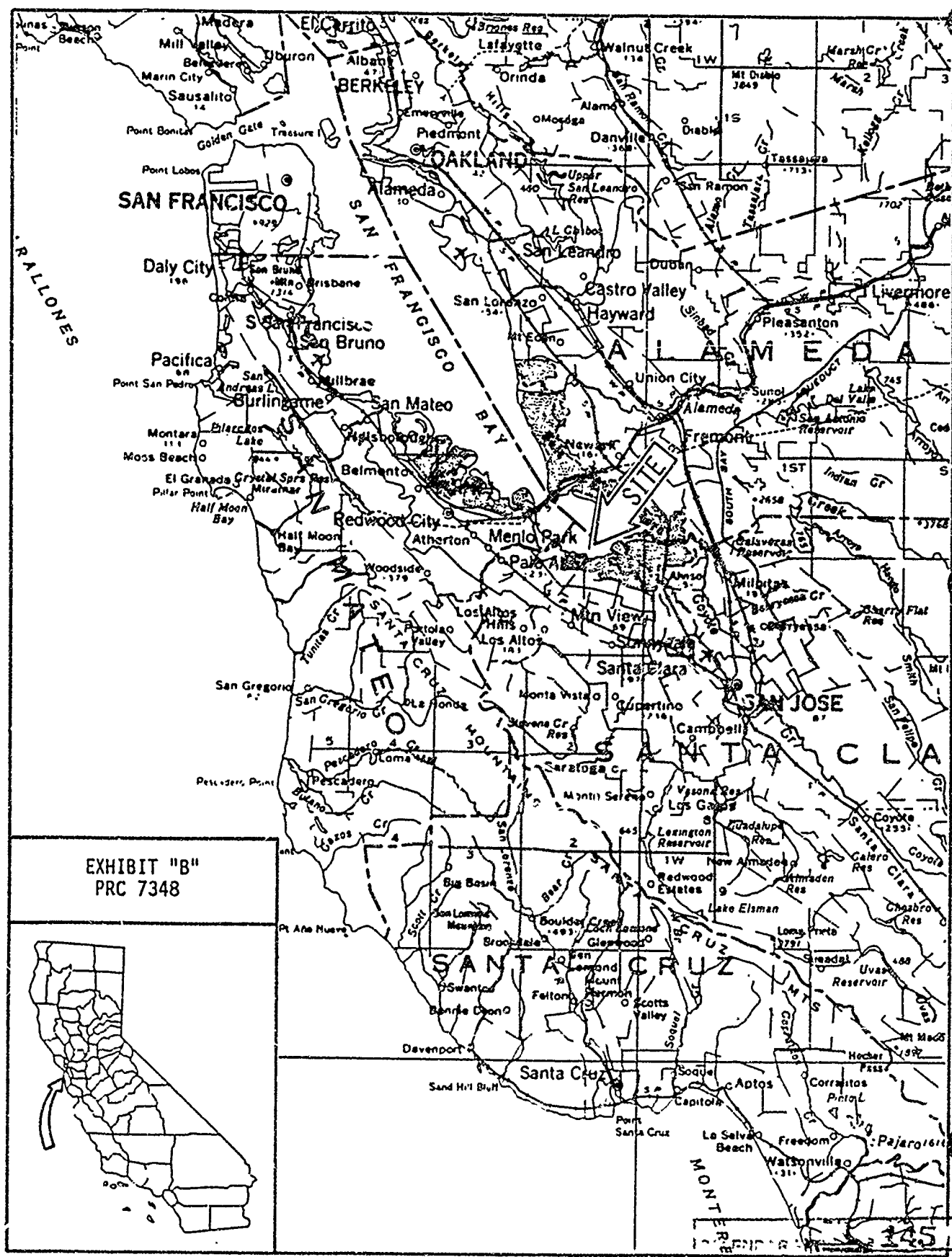
