SIGNIFICANT LANDS

INVENTORY FINDING:

THIS ACTIVITY INVOLVES LANDS WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN IDENTIFIED AS POSSESSING SIGNIFICANT ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ. HOWEVER, THE COMMISSION HAS DECLARED THAT ALL TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS ARE "SIGNIFICANT" BY NATURE OF THEIR PUBLIC OWNERSHIP (AS OPPOSED TO "ENVIRONMENTAL SIGNIFICANT").
