APPROVE ASSIGNMENTS OF INTERESTS IN STATE OIL AND GAS LEASES PRC 2199, PRC 2894 AND PRC 2920, MOLINO OFFSHORE FIELD, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

## AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

State oil and gas leases PRC 2199, PRC 2894 and PRC 2920 are located in the Gaviota area and include the Molino Offshore Field, Santa Barbara County. The leases consist of 3,840 acres (PRC 2199), 4,250 acres (PRC 2894) and 4,250 acres (PRC 2920) of offshore tide and submerged lands.

#### LAND USE:

Oil and gas production.

#### CURRENT LEASE TERMS:

Lease period:

20 Years plus CEQ years beginning July 25, 1958 for PRC 2199; June 28, 1962 for PRC 2894; and August 28, 1962 for PRC 2920.

Surety bond: \$50,000.

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## BACKGROUND:

The three leases were issued between July 25, 1958 and August 28, 1962. The ownership of these leases is divided between Shell Western E&P, Inc. (SWEPI) and Chevron U.S.A., Inc. (Chevron). Chevron and SWEPI own an undivided 50 percent interest in PRC 2894 and PRC 2920. Leasehold interests in PRC 2199 are as follows:

Chevron U.S.A., Inc.	South 1/2	66-2/3 percent
Chevron U.S.A., Inc.	North 1/2	100 percent

Chevron is the operator of State oil and gas leases PRC 2199 and PRC 2894. SWEPI is the operator of State oil and gas lease PRC 2920.

On June 27, 1994, an application was received from the Molino Energy Company (Molino Energy) for the assignment of SWEPI's interests in the three leases to Molino Energy Company. SWEPI has submitted documents consenting to the assignment of its interest in these leases.

Molino Energy is a California Joint Ventures Partnership established to develop the oil and gas reserves located on these leases. Partners in Molino Energy are Gaviota Energy Group, Inc. and Santa Barbara Facilities, Inc. Gaviota Energy Group and Santa Barbara Facilities, Inc. are both California corporations.

## PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing fee and processing costs have been received.


2. SLC legal and audit staffs have reviewed the qualifications and financial statements of the applicant and determined that the partnership is qualified to hold an interest in these leases.
