AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

768 acres;(three parcels) more or less, of school lands, two parcels near the town of Spangler and the other 25 miles east of Ridgecrest, San Bernardino County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Sheep grazing.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning July 27, 1997.

CONSIDERATION:

\$500 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$1,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

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
