## DREDGING LEASE

#### LESSEE:

Port of San Francisco Ferry Building San Francisco, California 94111

# AREA. LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Granted sovereign lands, minerals reserved, in San Francisco Bay at the Port of San Francisco, City and County of San Francisco.

# **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Dredge a maximum of 422,400 cubic yards of material to maintain a navigable depth. Dredged materials will be disposed of at the United States Army Corps of Engineers approved Alcatraz Disposal Site (SF-11).

### LEASE TERM:

Five years, beginning July 11, 1997.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged for aquatic disposal; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or for commercial sale purposes.

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The City and County of San Francisco categorically exempted the proposed project under the CEQA, Class 4(g). On June 19, 1997, the San Francisico Bay Conservation and Development Commission (SFBCDC) granted permit # 2-97 for the proposed project.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304(g).
