# LEASE RENEWAL GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL USE

#### LESSEE:

Richard M. Lonergan & Mary Halsted Lonergan Living Trust Agreement, Richard M. Lonergan and Mary Halsted Lonergan, Trustees 2969 Lake Street San Francisco, California 94121

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.01 acre, more or less, of sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Tahoma, El Dorado County.

## AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, two mooring buoys, and a swim float, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

#### PREVIOUS LEASE TERM(S):

Five years, beginning March 19, 1989.

# PROPOSED LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 19, 1994.

#### CONSIDERATION:

\$93 per year for the swim float; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term. No monetary consideration for the pier and two mooring buoys pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Provision of liability insurance for combined single limit coverage of \$500,000.

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Not withstanding any other provisions of this lease, Lessee agrees to provide written evidence to the Commission that the buoys are authorized by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency within two (2) years of the effective date of this lease.

# **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project (pier and buoys) is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a) (2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a statutority exempt project. The project (swim float) is exempt because it involves an "ongoing project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21169 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15261.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
