CALENDAR ITEM C15

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GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT OF WAY USE

APPLICANT:

Charles F. Hansen, Sr. 2404 Sandy Prairie Road Fortuna. California 95540

AREA. LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.01 acre, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Eel River, Fortuna, Humboldt County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Placement of a seasonal bridge crossing over the Eel River, as shown on the attached Exhibit A. The exact location of the bridge may vary from year to year within the lease premises because of river conditions.

LEASE TERM:

Four years, five months and 23 days, beginning July 8, 1997.

CONSIDERATION:

\$100 per year.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance coverage of no less than \$1,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. This lease authorizes the use of sufficient lands for the placement of a temporary crossing within the area depicted in Exhibit A to this lease. The crossing shall be placed and removed in accordance with criteria established in permits issued by the County of Humboldt, California Department of Fish and Game, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the California Coastal Commission.
- 2. The lease requires the lessee to have ownership or a leasehold interest in all parcels connected by the crossing(s).

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- 3. On July 8, 1997, the California Coastal Commission (CCC) granted Permit # 1-97-17 for this project under its certified regulatory program (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15251 (c)).
- 4. Staff has reviewed the document and determined that the conditions, as specified in Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15253 (b), have been met for the Commission to use the environmental analysis document certified by the CCC as a Negative Declaration equivalent in order to comply with the requirements of the CEQA.
- 5. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based on the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
