RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Patricia E. Nealon 5629 Garden Highway Sacramento, California 95837

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the Sacramento River, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an 8 foot x 20 foot floating boat dock and a 3 foot x 30 foot ramp.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning February 14, 1996.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The applicant purchased the upland and the floating boat dock and ramp on February 14, 1996, from the previous Lessee.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under

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Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
