## **RENEWAL OF MINERAL EXTRACTION LEASE NO. PRC 2036.1**

#### APPLICANT:

Moe Sand Company 4501 Tidewater Avenue Oakland, California 94601

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

232 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in San Francisco Bay, near Angel Island, Marin and San Francisco Counties.

## **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Extraction of sand and gravel for commercial sale. The annual minimum volume to be extracted is 50,000 cubic yards from the site shown on the attached Exhibit A. The material will be barged and unloaded at various upland locations in the bay area where it will be used for construction purposes.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning November 12, 1997, with unlimited successive renewals of ten years upon reasonable terms and conditions as provided in the original lease.

#### CONSIDERATION:

A phased-in royalty of 23% of the weighted average sales price commencing with 13% in 1997 and increasing by 3% in each of 1998 and 1999 and by 4% in 2000, with a minimum of \$0.65 per cubic yard. Land rent of \$2.00 per acre per year.

#### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$1,000,000.

Bond:

\$50,000

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## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. This lease was initially executed in November, 1957, for twenty years with unlimited successive ten year renewals. The lease has been previously renewed in 1977 and 1987.
- A new lease form will be utilized to bring the insurance and bond rates and standard covenants up to current California State Lands Commission standards.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15025), the staff prepared a Negative Declaration identified as CSLC ND 426 State Clearinghouse No. 87101301. Such Negative Declaration was prepared and circulated for public review pursuant to the provisions of the CEQA. The CSLC adopted the Negative Declaration on November 19, 1987.

Based upon the Initial Study, the Negative Declaration, the comments received in response thereto and informal consultations by CSLC staff with the California Department of Fish and Game and San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission, there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15074 (b).


