CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE ASSIGNMENT OF UNDIVIDED INTEREST IN OIL AND GAS LEASE NO. PRC 7542, SACRAMENTO AND SAN JOAQUIN COUNTIES

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 7542 (Isleton Gas Unit) encompasses a portion of Agreement for Easement E-415.1, in the beds of the Sacramento River and Georgiana Slough, which lands are in Sacramento and San Joaquin Counties

BACKGROUND:

An agreement for Easement 415.1, covering approximately 2,827 acres of sovereign land of the State in the Rio Vista Gas Field in Contra Costa, Sacramento, San Joaquin and Solano Counties, was issued, pursuant to competitive public bidding, for a term of 20 years on June 3, 1940, to the Standard Oil Company of California, now Chevron U.S.A., Inc. The agreement was modified on November 1, 1950, by the formation of the Isleton Gas Field Unit (PRC 7542), which included Easement 415.1 and is exclusive of the horizons and zones included in the Rio Vista Gas Unit. Section 2(o) of the agreement provides, in part, that the holder of the easement may not assign, transfer or sublet its interest, without the prior consent in writing of the State.

Through a series of assignments, Casex Company (Casex) is the present

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lessee of Lease No. PRC 7542 and Casex is the operator for the lease. Enron Oil and Gas Company (Enron) is now requesting that the State Lands Commission approve assignment of 100 percent interest in this lease to Enron.
