#### DREDGING LEASE

#### LESSEE:

Schnitzer Steel Products Company P. O. Box 747 Oakland, California 94604

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Granted sovereign lands with minerals reserved, in Oakland Inner Harbor Channel, at the applicant's recycling wharf, Alameda County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Maintenance dredge a maximum of 75,000 cubic yards of material to maintain a navigable depth. Dredged materials will be disposed of at the United States Army Corps of Engineers approved Alcatraz Disposal Site (SF-11).

#### **LEASE TERM:**

Five years, beginning July 1, 1998.

#### **CONSIDERATION:**

No royalty will be charged for disposal of dredged material; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304(g).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300.

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating

DREDGED MATERIALS WILL BE DISPOSED OF AT THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS APPROVED ALCATRAZ DISPOSAL SITE (SF-11). SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED FOR DISPOSAL OF DREDGED MATERIAL; \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR ANY MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES.
