**GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE****LESSEE:**

City of Redding  
777 Auditorium Drive  
Redding, California 96001

**AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:**

0.35 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, near the  
city of Redding, Shasta County.

**AUTHORIZED USE:**

The construction and maintenance of a 26 foot x 585 foot pedestrian bridge at  
Turtle Bay (River Mile 297.6).

**LEASE TERM:**

25 years, beginning June 1, 1998.

**CONSIDERATION:**

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a  
monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best  
interest.

**OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

1. Applicant is the owner of one of the uplands (APN 102-040-01) and has  
the rights to the other upland (APN 112-270-13) adjoining the lease  
premises.
2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this  
project by the city of Redding. The California State Lands Commission's  
staff has reviewed such document.

3. A Mitigation Monitoring Program was adopted by the City of Redding.
4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
5. The Master Plan for the city of Redding includes the further development of a major trail system that traverses both sides of the Sacramento River. The City's Sacramento River Trail system provides the community with a non-motorized transportation alternative that connects residential, commercial, recreational, and cultural sectors of the city.

One of the prime components of the trail program is a pedestrian/bicycle bridge across the Sacramento River at Turtle Bay which is the subject of this Calendar Item. The pedestrian bridge will ultimately lie at the center of the completed trail system. The bridge will connect the Sacramento River Trail between the Redding Arboretum (also known as Arboretum On the River) and the Turtle Bay Museums.

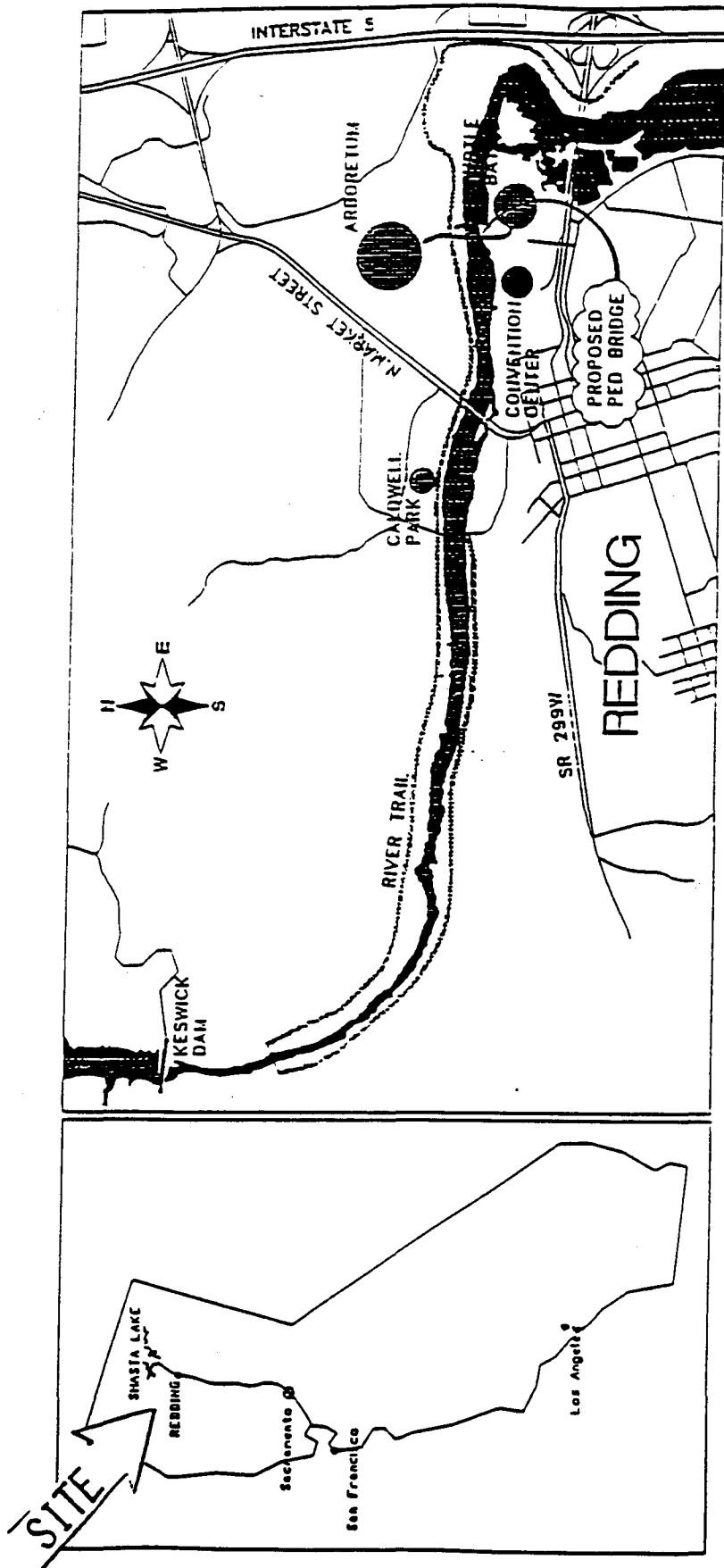


**Pedestrian Bridge at Turtle Bay
