GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT:

Stillwater Yacht Club P.O. Box 561 Pebble Beach, California 93953

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.71 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in Stillwater Cove, Carmel Bay, near the city of Carmel, Monterey County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Installation and maintenance of 23 mooring buoys and two 10-foot by 12-foot floating wood platforms, seasonally from May 15th to September 30th of each year of the lease.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning November 1, 1997.

CONSIDERATION:

\$2,356 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of no less than \$1,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant has a right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. The mooring buoys and floating platforms are installed on a seasonal basis from May 15th to September 30th of each year, and are used in conjunction with the Club's sailing program.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the

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staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO STILLWATER YACHT CLUB OF A GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL USE, BEGINNING NOVEMBER 1, 1997, FOR A TERM OF TEN YEARS, FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF 23 MOORING BUOYS AND TWO FLOATING WOOD PLATFORMS, SEASONALLY FROM MAY 15TH TO SEPTEMBER 30TH OF EACH YEAR ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,356, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENT PERIODICALLY DURING THE LEASE TERM, AS PROVIDED IN THE LEASE; LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF NO LESS THAN \$1,000,000.

LAND DESCRIPTION

Twenty-five parcels of tide and submerged land in Stillwater Cove, Carmel Bay, Monterey County, California, lying immediately beneath 23 buoys and 2 floats TOGETHER WITH a necessary use area extending 20 feet from each buoy and 10 feet from the extremities of each float, said buoys and floats lying southerly of that certain 1.620 acre parcel of land, so shown and designated on "Record of Survey of a Portion of Rancho El Pescadero, Monterey County, California", filed for record in Volume X-1, page 172 of Surveys, Monterey County.
