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RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Richard J. Ferris and Kelsey K. Ferris 1436 Ridge Road Northbrook, Illinois 60062

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Dollar Point, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

The reconstruction and modification of a pier, removal of a boathouse, installation of a boat lift and retention of two existing mooring buoys, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning September 1, 1995.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

This lease is conditioned on Lessee's obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years from the effective date of the authorization of the buoys by the Commission.
