RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Lloyd A. Lundstrom, Jr. and Geraldine M. Lundstrom, Trustees under Lundstrom Family Revocable Living Trust dated December 21, 1991 554 Miner Road Orinda, California 94563

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Carnelian Bay, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of a pier, boathouse, boat hoist, and one mooring buoy, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning April 1, 1998.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

This lease is conditioned on Lessee's obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoy within two years from the effective date of the authorization of the buoy by the Commission.
