### **AMENDMENT OF PERMIT**

#### PERMITTEE:

Truckee-Donner Recreation and Park District 10046 Church Street
Truckee, California 96161

## AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Donner Lake, near Truckee, Nevada County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Use and maintenance of 12 piers.

#### **PERMIT TERM:**

49 years, beginning August 1, 1974.

#### **CONSIDERATION:**

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

#### PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Include 25 additional piers, for a total of 37. All other terms and conditions of the permit shall remain in effect without amendment.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On June 6, 1974, the Commission approved a 49-year Public Agency Permit to the Truckee Donner Recreation and Park District (District), effective August 1, 1974, for the maintenance and repair of twelve recreational piers for public use. During the winter storms of '96 and '97, many of the piers were damaged or destroyed. The District wishes to repair and rebuild the damaged piers.

The District has since acquired shoreline property containing 25 existing piers, and is requesting the existing permit be amended for a total of 37

piers.

2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; (ten piers) and Class 2, Reconstruction or Replacement (27 piers); Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2), and Title 14, California Code of Regulations section 15302.
