APPLICANT:

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San Marcos Properties, a General Partnership One Gardiner Court Orinda, California 94563

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.12 acre, more or less, of sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Tahoe Vista, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of four mooring buoys, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

1.

Ten years, beginning October 15, 1998.

CONSIDERATION:

\$372 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$1,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Lessee is the owner of Assessor's Parcel Numbers 117-110-17 and 18. The lease premises lie adjacent to and in front of these two parcels. This lease provides for the authorization of two buoys per parcel, and that the buoys shall be permitted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the State Lands Commission and the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency at all times. If at any time after the execution of this lease, either parcel is sold or otherwise transferred, only two buoys may be transferred or assigned in conjunction with the sale of the upland parcel.
