AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

1,456 acres, more or less, of tide and sumberged lands in San Francisco Bay, San Francisco and Marin Counties.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued extraction of sand and gravel for commercial use.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning July 1, 1998.


CONSIDERATION:

Land rent of \$2 per acre or \$2,912 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

Royalty of 23% of gross sales value, and a minimum biannual royalty of \$140,750; with the State reserving the right to fix a different royalty periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Section 3, Paragraph 19, provides that subject to prior written consent of Lessor, Lessee may assign the leases or any interest in them.



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2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21065 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15378.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


