**PROPOSED ACTIVITY**

The Executive Officer requests delegation of authority to execute renewal of service agreements for 1999-2000 fiscal year. Bids and awards shall be conducted consistent with procedures as specified in the State Contracts Manual and the Public Contract Code.

1. Department of Justice (\$700,000.00) C99001

Interagency Agreement to provide legal services and representation concerning the Commission's interest under Chapter 138/64 1st E.S. and the Alamitos Bay Litigation. All costs reimbursed by the City of Long Beach.

3. County Assessors' Records (\$25,000.00) C99002

Contract or to provide on-line access to County Assessors' records and CD-ROM of Assessors' maps for all 58 counties of California.

1. FIND THAT THESE ACTIVITIES ARE EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL CODE REGS. 15061 BECAUSE THESE ACTIVITIES ARE NOT PROJECTS AS DEFINED BY PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 21065 AND 14 CAL CODE REGS. 15378.
2. AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO SOLICIT BIDS, AWARD AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS AND INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES.
