CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE AWARD OF THE CRUDE OIL SALES CONTRACTS, TRACT NO. 1, LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LOS ANGELES COUNTY


BACKGROUND:

At its meeting on January 29, 1999, the California State Lands Commission authorized the sale of crude oil from Tract No. 1, Long Beach Unit, Wilmington Oil Field, in Los Angeles County. Paramount Petroleum Corporation and Bravo Energy Company are presently purchasing the City's share of crude oil from Tract No. 1. Under two separate sales contracts: one for seven percent (7%) Segment and one for five and a half percent (5 ½%) Segment of the Tract No. 1 oil, Paramount and Bravo are paying the City bonuses of \$0.52 and \$0.44, respectively, per barrel above a base price as defined in the Crude Oil Sales Contracts. The present crude oil sales contacts will expire on March 1, 2000.

A Notice Inviting Bids for a new Crude Oil Sales Contract to run from March 1, 2000 until September 1, 2001 was published in the Long Beach Press Telegram on April 21, 1999, and sent to all known interested parties. Bids were received and opened on May 12, 1999. Exhibit A shows the results of the bidding.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Fiscal and Legal reviews of the submitted bid material were done by the CSLC and City Auditing and Legal Units respectively. Based on the results of these reviews, the highest responsible bidder has been identified on Exhibit A. Staff

recommends awarding of the new Crude Oil Sales Contracts for Tract No. 1, Long Beach Unit to the highest responsible bidders identified on Exhibit A.
