TERMINATION OF GENERAL PERMIT – PUBLIC AGENCY USE NO. PRC 7351.9 AND ISSUANCE OF A NEW GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

LESSEE:

Anderson-Cottonwood Irrigation District (ACID) 2810 Silver Street Anderson, California 96007

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, adjacent to Caldwell Park, near the city of Redding, Shasta County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Construction of a south bank fish ladder and main diversion fish screen.

LEASE TERM:

25 years, beginning November 1, 1999.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant has a right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On October 26, 1989, the Commission issued to the California Department of Fish and Game a General Permit – Public Agency Use No. PRC 7351.9 for the construction, use and maintenance of the south bank fish ladder on the existing ACID dam. By memorandum dated September 16, 1999, the California Department of Fish and Game is releasing their interest in this site at this time because the fish ladder and fish screen facilities are being completely replaced and will be under the control of the ACID. The California Department of Fish and Game will

continue to access State land at this site to conduct fish monitoring activities and provide occasional assistance to the ACID.

- 3. A Mitigated Negative Declaration (SCH #99042076) and Mitigation Monitoring Program were prepared and adopted for this project by the Anderson-Cottonwood Irrigation District. The California State Lands Commission staff has reviewed such documents.
- 4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.




