DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Shore Terminals, LLC 2801 Waterfront Road Martinez, CA 94553

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Suisun Bay, city of Martinez, Contra Costa County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Dredge a maximum of 60,000 cubic yards of material to maintain a navigable depth with deposition of the dredged materials at the United States Army Corps of Engineers approved Carquinez Site (SF-9).

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning April 20, 2000; through April 19, 2010.

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or for commerical sale purposes.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulation, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304 (g).

Authority: Public Resource Code section 21804 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300.

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code section

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6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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MAINTAIN A NAVIGABLE DEPTH. DREDGED MATERIAL WILL BE DISPOSED OF AT THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS CARQUINEZ DISPOSAL SITE (SF-9). SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED AS THE PROJECT WILL RESULT IN A PUBLIC BENEFIT; \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR ANY MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES.
