### GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL AND PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE USE

#### **APPLICANTS**:

James A. Carter and Judith M. Carter P. O. Box 800 West Sacramento, California 95691

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### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, adjacent to the Garden Highway, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

## AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 20 foot by 38 foot floating dock, access ramp, debris deflector, and 900 cubic yards of rock and concrete riprap.

### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning July 1, 1998.

### **CONSIDERATION:**

Recreational Pier - no monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5; Bank Protection - the public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance:

Combined single limit coverage of no less than \$500,000.

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## **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
