RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Jeffrey A. Hart 13737 Grand Island Road Walnut Grove, California 95690

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Steamboat Slough, near Walnut Grove, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Construction of a 21 foot by 48 foot floating dock with a 3 foot by 70 foot gangway.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 15, 2000.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(1).
