#### DREDGING LEASE

#### APPLICANT:

Kiewit Pacific Company P.O. Box 1769 Vancouver, Washington 98668

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Granted sovereign lands with minerals reserved and ungranted sovereign lands at the Vallejo Waterfront, Mare Island Strait (Napa River), city of Vallejo, Solano County.

# **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Dredge a maximum of 98,115 cubic yards of material to maintain a navigational channel.

Deposition of dredge materials at the United States Army Corps of Engineers approved Carquinez Strait Site (SF-9)

#### LEASE TERM:

Five years, beginning July 1, 2000.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged for aquatic disposal; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or for commercial sale purposes.

#### **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304(g).

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Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300.

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant, to Public Resources Code section 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED AS THE PROJECT WILL RESULT IN A PUBLIC BENEFIT; \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD WILL BE CHARGED FOR ANY MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES.

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
