DREDGING AND DISPOSAL LEASE

APPLICANT:

Crescent City Harbor District
101 Citizens Dock Road
Crescent City, CA 95531

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Maintenance dredging in Crescent City Harbor and Channel, near
Crescent City, Del Norte County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredging a maximum of 100,000 cubic yards of material
annually in the Crescent City Harbor. The dredged material will be
disposed of at two designated disposal sites; the uplands disposal site just
to the west of the inner basin and the surf zone just to the east of the
Whaler Island causeway.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 1, 2000.

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged as the project will result in a public benefit. A
royalty of a minimum of \$0.25 per cubic yard shall be paid for any material
sold or used for any private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State
CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations,
section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt
from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt
project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to
Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304(g).

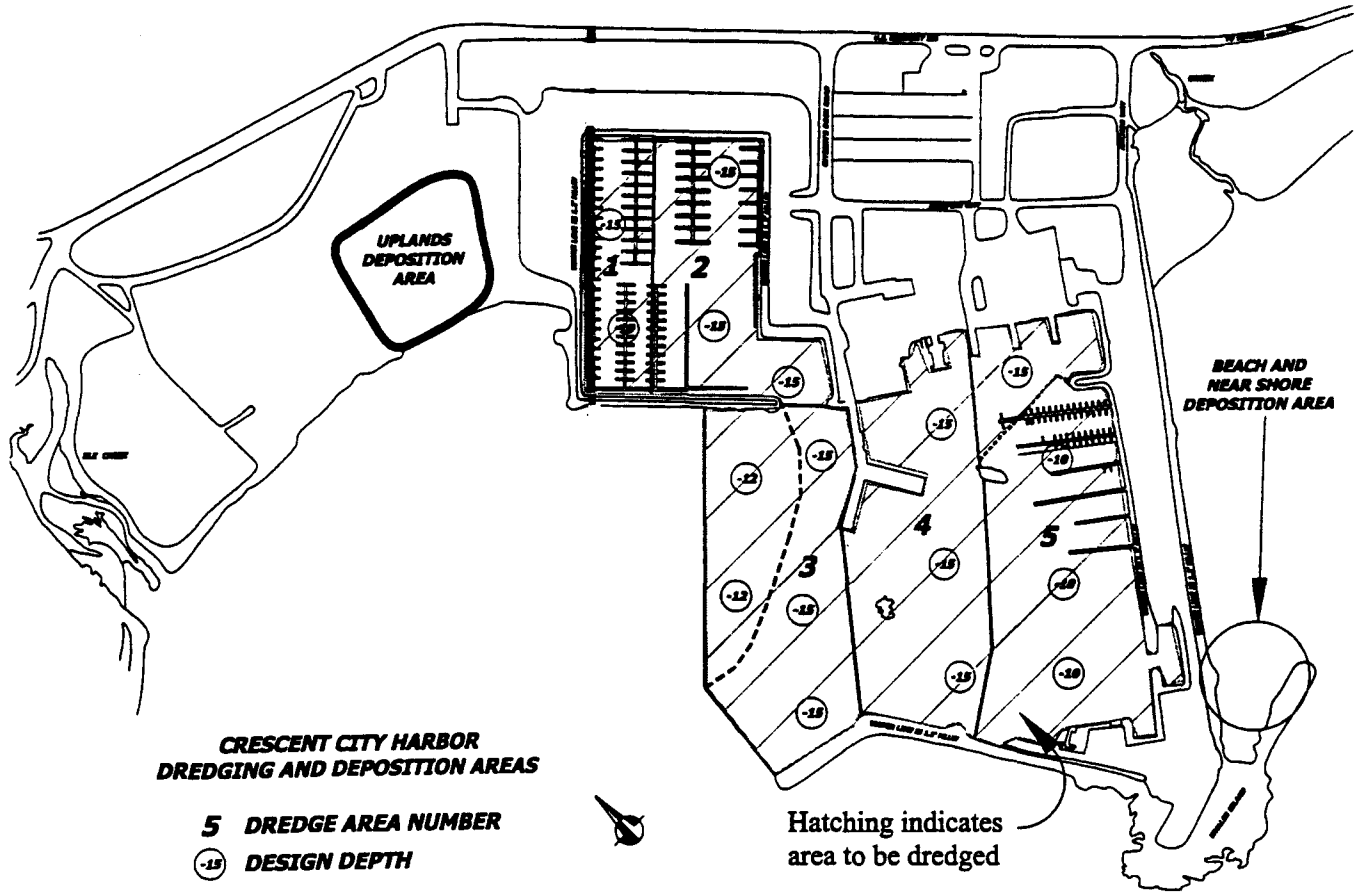
AUTHORIZATION:

AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A DREDGING AND DISPOSAL LEASE TO CRESCENT CITY HARBOR BEGINNING AUGUST 1, 2000, FOR A TERM OF TEN YEARS, ENDING ON JULY 31, 2010, FOR MAINTENANCE DREDGING OF A MAXIMUM OF 100,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL ANNUALLY IN THE CRESCENT CITY HARBOR; DREDGED MATERIAL WILL BE DISPOSED OF AT TWO DESIGNATED DISPOSAL SITES, THE UPLANDS DISPOSAL SITE JUST TO THE WEST OF THE INNER BASIN AND THE SURF ZONE JUST TO THE EAST OF THE WHALER ISLAND CAUSEWAY ON THE LANDS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED BECAUSE THE PROJECT IS FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT. A ROYALTY OF A MINIMUM OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR ANY MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.

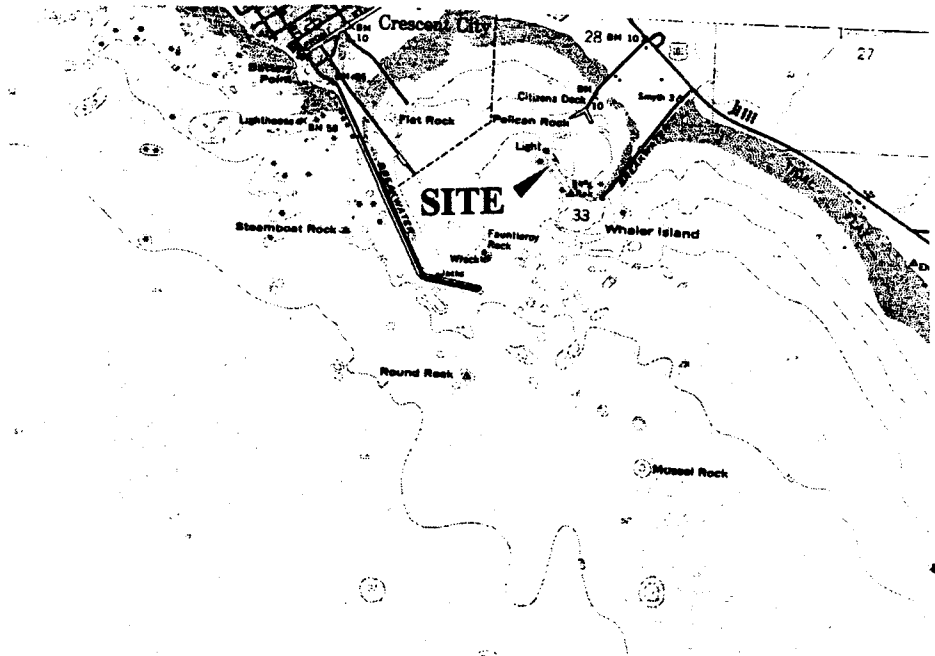
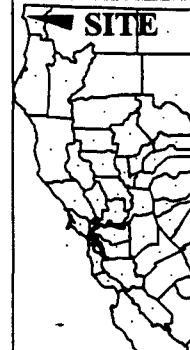
