CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF A QUITCLAIM DEED AND TERMINATION OF GENERAL LEASE – COMMERCIAL USE

LESSEE:

Dennis Kawahara and Yolanda Kawahara 11711 Highway 160 Courtland, California 95615

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.12 acres, more or less, of tide and submerged lands in the Sacramento River, near the town of Courtland, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

A 6 foot by 200 foot guest dock and 12 foot x 84 foot ramp/platform with connecting gangway, including full disability access and parking.

LEASE TERM:


