RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Don J. Angel and Jean Angel

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the Sacramento River, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing floating boat dock, gangway, and concrete steps.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning March 1, 2003.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 On April 28, 1993, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Permit with Don J. and Jean Angel. That lease will expire on February 28, 2003. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Don J. and Jean Angel are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
