Ten years, beginning May 30, 2003.

 On May 31, 1993, the Commission approved a Recreational Pier Lease to Jane Triest Burrows and Bertram Sumner Burrows, Trustees of the of the Sumner and Jane Burrows Community Property Trust dated November 7, 1989. Jane Triest Burrows is the sole Trustee of such trust upon the death of her husband Sumner Burrows on September 6, 2001. Jane Triest Burrows is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and uses the upland for a single-family dwelling.
