GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT OF WAY USE

APPLICANT:

Wild Goose Storage, Inc. 3900, 421 Seventh Avenue, SW Calgary, Alberta, Canada T2P 4K9

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.10 acres, more or less, of submerged lands in the Sacramento River, east of the town of Delevan, Colusa County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Installation of a horizontal directionally drilled 36-inch diameter natural gas pipeline and two fiber optic cables.

LEASE TERM:

20 years, beginning February 21, 2003.

CONSIDERATION:

\$250 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance: Liability Limits of \$250,000,000.

Guarantee: Corporate Guarantee of \$5,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant has a right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) initially granted Wild Goose Storage, Inc. (WGSI) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) on June 25, 1997, to develop, construct and operate an

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underground natural gas storage facility in Butte County, California and to provide firm and interruptible storage services at market-based rates. On June 18, 2001, WSGI filed an application with the CPUC for an amended CPCN to expand the permitted storage and operational capacity of the WGSI storage field located in Butte County. WGSI also sought approval to construct a 25.6-mile pipeline from the WGSI Remote Facility Site to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) Line 400/401 transmission pipeline in Colusa County. The purpose of the Expansion Project is to maximize the storage, injection, and withdrawal capacity of the natural gas storage reservoir with a connection to the PG&E Line 400/401 to meet customer demands into the foreseeable future.

- 3. WGSI proposes to install a horizontal directionally drilled 36-inch diameter natural gas pipeline 50 feet below the Sacramento River for a total length of 344 feet. In addition, two fiber optic cables, one primary and one backup, will be installed to provide operational control of valves and other monitoring equipment along the pipeline route and throughout the proposed Delevan Interconnect Facility. A 4-inch diameter steel casing will be installed along with the gas pipeline to provide conduit for the fiber optic cable.
- 4. Alenco, Inc. has provided a Guarantee for the performance of the lease obligations of its subsidiary, Wild Goose Storage, Inc.
- 5. An EIR was prepared and certified for this project by the California Public Utilities Commission. The California State Lands Commission staff has reviewed such document and Mitigation Monitoring Program adopted by the lead agency.
- 6. Findings made in conformance with the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, sections 15091 and 15096) are on file in the Sacramento Office of the California State Lands Commission.
- A Statement of Overriding Considerations made in conformance with the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15093) is on file in the Sacramento Office of the California State Lands Commission.

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The Statement of Overriding Considerations is required due to the potential for permanent conversion of Prime Farmland to other uses at the Remote Facility and at the valve lots. The impacts identified would be significant and unavoidable, and would not occur on or be generated from the State-owned land.

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
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

OF A GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT OF WAY USE, BEGINNING FEBRUARY 21, 2003, FOR A TERM OF 20 YEARS, FOR INSTALLATION OF A HORIZONTAL DIRECTIONALLY DRILLED NATURAL GAS PIPELINE AND TWO FIBER OPTIC CABLES ON THE LAND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENT PERIODICALLY DURING THE LEASE TERM, AS PROVIDED IN THE LEASE; LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000,000 PER OCCURRENCE FOR BODILY INJURY AND FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE; AND A CORPORATE GUARANTEE OF \$5,000,000.





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
