GENERAL LEASE-RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANTS:

Dale R. Elder and Cora R. Elder

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.03 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in Eagle Lake near Susanville, Lassen County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing portable pier in Eagle Lake as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning January 1, 2003.

CONSIDERATION:

\$288 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$500,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- On January 17, 1990, the Commission authorized a General Lease -Recreational Use to James A. Walker. That lease expired on November 30, 1999. Applicants purchased the property from James A. Walker on March 15, 2002, and are now applying for a new General Lease - Recreational Use.
- 2. Applicants do not qualify for a rent-free lease because Applicants are not littoral owners. The upland property is U.S. Forest Service land of the Eagle Nest recreational residence tract. Applicants have obtained a Special Use Permit from the U.S. Forest Service for the use of the upland property.

3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
